Are you getting the most out of your slam bidding? Many players have difficulties finding slams. They don't know when it's right to bid Blackwood and when it is right to investigate slams through another method. One problem is that slams don't come up often enough for players to get sufficient practice in bidding and making slams. This course will solve your problems.

In this Five Session course we will look at when it is right to look for slams; how to bid makeable slams with fewer than 30 high card points; whether it is best to cue bid or to make a Blackwood inquiry; the advantages of Key Card Blackwood over regular Blackwood; king-ask and queen-ask bidding inquiries; right-siding the contract; when to bid on to Grand Slam; how to find Minor Suit slams; and how best to ensure that you make your slam contract once you have bid it.

We will cover a number of conventions that will help you to investigate slams including Jacoby 2NT, Roman Key Card Blackwood, Splinter Bids, and Minorwood.
