

STRONG HANDS – Reverses, Blackwood & Cuebidding

Bridge players LOVE to have good cards! But it's necessary to have the bidding skills to reach the optimum contract with strong hands. This short series will look at bidding methods designed to communicate your strength and distribution.

First, an important concept for advancing players to understand is a Reverse bid, which will be demonstrated with lots of practice hands. Second, we will look at basic Blackwood and not-so-basic elements of this convention. Finally, we will practice cuebidding for slam, when simply asking for Aces would not apply.

Bring your thinking cap and invite your bridge friends for this interesting series. It is not necessary to have a partner to participate. While the focus will be on bidding, other elements of play and defense will also offer challenges. It will be fun, though, as is all bridge play!!
