

## **Fall Course 2019 – Taking the Proper Line as Declarer**

Have you noticed that some players at the club seem to win time and again? They seem to have a knack for scoring an extra trick or two when they play the hand as Declarer. Getting those extra tricks takes a combination of knowing probabilities, choosing which suits to develop, and playing suits in the right order. These are skills that can and should be learned.

In this five part program, we will look at probabilities which will help you to determine the proper line to take as Declarer. Subjects include: evaluating the hand at Trick 1; suit distributions; choosing the right suit to develop; deciding when to finesse; determining when it is right to set up a long suit; and evaluating alternate chances.

This course will be an eye-opener for most players. Please note: this is a challenging intermediate to advanced-intermediate course that is not appropriate for beginners.

You may come with or without a partner. There will be lots of hands to bid and play each session! Bridge classes are a good way to meet other local players and to develop partnerships and foursomes.
