

Competitive Bidding in the 21st Century

When you've opened the bidding and your opponents come into the auction, it has now become competitive. Or vice-versa -- you overcall or double when your opponents open, so it's now a competition for declaring the contract.

There is lots of strategy involved when either scenario occurs.

- Did you wish to push the opponents higher?
- Were you hoping to double their contract?
- Are you willing to keep bidding just so the opponents cannot declare?

This series of lessons will attempt to answer some of the above questions. We will also examine the overcall and double structure so your side will have a solid understanding of how to compete.
