

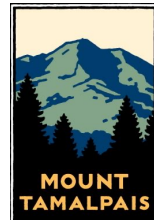

Traveling South on 101 : Exit Lucky Dr (450A), continue on Fifer to end, left onto Lucky Dr, right on Doherty Dr and follow event signs to the covered Redwood High parking lot.

Traveling North on 101: Exit Lucky Dr, right onto Redwood Hwy, right at first signal (Wornum Dr), right on Tamal Vista, left on Fifer, left on Lucky Dr, right onto Doherty and follow event signs to the covered Redwood High parking lot.
